

## EUROPEAN MONARCHY CHARACTER CONNECTION

- Students are permitted to work in groups of 3
- Students are to select one of the following groups to complete
- Students are to find a connection between the historical figure and a character/celebrity showing the same character traits or behaviors
- Students are to consult class notes and one biography of each person from the high school library portal. Students are to annotate the biography for each historical figure
- Students are to find a different modern celebrity or character for each historical figure
- Modern celebrities can be found from music, movies, or television
- Students may also substitute an actual celebrity with a character from movies or television
- Students must make a *specific* connection between the historical figure and celebrity/character
- All connections and pictures must be *school appropriate*
- Students are to create a power point demonstrating the following:
  - Pictures of both character/celebrity
  - One paragraph description connecting the *specific* similarities of the character/celebrity
  - Power point must be saved properly and electronically sent (Last Names\_Character Connection\_Period)
