

ON LINE DISCUSSION PRIMARY DOCUMENTS

For certain units, students will post their primary document analysis online. Articles are pre-selected and primary document support pages are available.

Located on the wiki, a page has been created with the names of each of the primary documents. Within the page students will use the discussion page and posts created by Mr. Moritz.

Under the discussion tab, discussions have been created based on the typical sections of the primary documents; Bias of the Author, Background Information, Bias of the Receiver, Impact of the Document, and Reflection.

Students are to post 5 times in 5 different places.

Students need to create original posts, meaning they are allowed to agree or disagree with the information provided prior to your post; however you are required to introduce new information to the discussion thread.

STUDENTS MUST CAPITALIZE THEIR NEW INFORMATION IN THEIR POST. JUST LIKE I AM DOING NOW.

YOU MUST ALSO CAPITALIZE MATERIAL FROM THE SUPPLEMENTAL ARTICLES. Remember to use proper citations when doing this. All 5 posts must have support from the supplemental articles.

Students cannot reply to their own posts, or respond to discussion within the thread they participated within. Each section is limited to 13 posts. Students must write at least 300 words for each of their 5 posts. Students are to provide a word count at the end of the post. Remember to use proper discussion language and techniques. Any direct attacks on another student will not be accepted.

All classes are working together, meaning you are not separated by your class period.

This assignment is to be completed by the day and period of the test. It is in your best interest to post early.
